Safety & Welfare

- Whitley Beaumont is a Scout Association Camp Site and as such all users must agree to abide by the Scout Association's Child Protection code of practice. This code is contained on the 'Young People First' card which all adults in Scouting should have. In particular it must be understood that any contravention of the code of practice could lead to the Scout Association initiating its own reporting and referral procedures. If your organisation has its own child protection code of practice, please have a copy available.
- Scout Association Insurance ONLY covers members of the Scout Association. If you are a non-Scout Association organisation YOU ARE NOT COVERED BY US and must arrange your own insurance cover for everything involved during your stay at the site.
- Do not leave your campsite unattended.
- Campers should ensure they have their own First Aid provision appropriate to the activity being undertaken.
- Fire extinguishers are located in The Main Building and the top ladies toilets. You should consider bringing your own, dependant on the activities you are undertaking and associated risk assessments.
- **Access**
- Please respect our neighbours and the boundary of the site. The site perimeter is marked by either a dry stone wall or fence and is shown on the site plan which is supplied at time of booking.
- Access to site is via the narrow unmetalled, unlit track from Town End Lane only and is not suitable for vehicles with low ground clearance. There are no passing places.
- Only leaders' vehicles and those carrying equipment are permitted to site and should be parked in the car park area. Vehicle access beyond the car park may be permitted and should be discussed with the Duty Warden.
- All campers and day visitors should be dropped off at Pinfold Lane and walk to site (of $\frac{3}{4}$ mile).
- The site gates should be kept closed to deter trespassers.
- During large camps it is advisable to implement traffic control on the lane to avoid gridlock. Radios are available from the warden.
- In the event of the emergency services being required, camp leaders should ensure that access via the lane is unobstructed.

Water - (included in camp fees)

There is a site supply switch in The Main Building kitchen which must be switched on for water to flow. External taps are located around the site – please see the campsite map. Please be mindful that the site is metered.

Electricity – (included in camp fees)

Electricity is included in site fees, except for the heating in The Main Building which requires £1 in the meter. The lights in the toilets and car park are automated and require no switching. In the event of any issues, contact the Duty Warden.

Gas – (included in the Main Building hire fee)

Bottled gas is located in the locker outside the Main Building kitchen and supplies the water heater and oven. Instructions are located on the door inside the locker. There is also an isolation valve in the kitchen next to the boiler.

Main Building

The Main Building (formerly the Activity Hut/Training Hut) 11 x 5m approx has 2 rooms - a fully equipped kitchen and hall with chairs & tables. The Lower Toilet Block is attached to the building with hot/cold water and 1 shower. Pitch 1 adjacent to the building is included in the hire for camping and activities. Please note that hire of the Main Building at weekends is for a minimum of 2 nights and that the cost of hire (both weekends and mid week) is payable in advance of your stay.

The kitchen has cutlery/crockery/utensils. Please check these are sufficient for your numbers. You should bring sponges/cloths/sprays/washing up liquid/teatowels etc. None of the pots/pans are to be used on open fires. The main kitchen equipment includes: 2 large fridge/freezer units, hot water boiler, 6 ring commercial gas oven, kettle, toaster, microwave and twin sinks with on-demand hot water & draining boards

Small Building

The Small Building (formerly the Warden's Hut) 4.5 x 3.5m approx is situated at the top of the site. Facilities in a single room include cold water tap, kettle, microwave, fridge, toaster and tables & benches. Please note there are no pans, cutlery or utensils.

Toilets

There are male and female toilets in the Upper Toilet Block with cold water only. The Lower Toilet Block is attached to The Main Building and is split into male and female. The female side also has an electric shower. Both hot and cold water are supplied to all sinks in the Lower Toilet Block. Soap, toilet paper, sanitary bags and paper hand towels are provided in both toilet blocks.

Fires

If you plan to have any type of fire on site, this must be discussed with the Duty Warden. There is a campfire circle located at the top of the site adjacent to Pitch 5 and an open fire area adjacent to Pitch 1 near the Main Building. The BBQs and alter fires may be used throughout the site on the basis that every effort is made to protect the grass and all wood debris is cleared from the Pitches.

Activities

We have equipment for a water slide, pioneering, orienteering and picture trail. Please enquire when booking. Additional fees may apply.

Music

Please note in respect of music licences required for any music being played in public that failure to obtain a licence may be a breach of copyright and be subject to prosecution. Whitley Beaumont Scout Camp does not hold the required licences.

Departure

There are currently no facilities for rubbish disposal at site and all waste must be removed from site at the end of your stay. Please ensure the site is left litter free ready for the next campers by conducting a litter pick.

You must ensure all actions on the departure checklist are completed to a standard that is satisfactory to the Duty Warden.

Duty Warden

If during your stay you have any problems please contact the **Duty Warden** in the first instance. Please also notify us of any damages/defects so we are aware and can arrange repairs or replacements.
